## Holy Trinity School Capital Campaign

The Holy Trinity School Capital Campaign is an effort to raise much needed funds to help improve our school's infrastructure so that we can continue to offer a high quality Catholic education to our current and future students.

Holy Trinity School just celebrated its 100th year in 2016 and was named a National Blue Ribbon School in 2011. We provide pre-school through 8th grade education to students from Westfield, Mountainside, Cranford, Scotch Plains, Fanwood, Plainfield, Union, and surrounding communities.

### What is the goal of the campaign?

The goal of the campaign is to raise \$500,000 to fund the following projects at our school:

- New roof for the entire school and Event Center
- New Event Center floor and facility improvements
- Educational and technology improvements

### Why have we chosen these improvements?

The current facilities are in desperate need of repair and upgrade. The entirety of the school's roof needs to be replaced as routine maintenance is no longer a viable option to sustain it.

The school's Event Center is an integral component of the school's academic, social, and athletic programs. On any given day, you will find a gym period, afterschool sports practice, music rehearsal, drama club productions, scouts, social events for families, fundraising events, school committee meetings, etc. It also is one of the first places that families from the surrounding communities experience when they come to Holy Trinity School.



We are also looking to make an investment in our school's educational capabilities to complement the improvements to the facilities which could include the addition of technology to our classrooms or other upgrades to our equipment and programs.

### Who else is helping to fund this campaign?

The Catholic Church of the Holy Trinity, located across the street from Holy Trinity School has graciously agreed to match contributions to our campaign up to \$100,000. This is in recognition of their current and continued use of the facility and our shared commitment to Holy Trinity School's future.

### What if we raise extra money?

Funds raised above and beyond the much-needed repairs will become part of the Holy Trinity Blue & Gold Foundation's general fund account. The primary focus of the Blue & Gold Foundation is to provide financial assistance to support the school's physical plant, academic offerings, and athletic programs. The Blue & Gold Foundation will help maintain and improve the athletic and academic facilities of our campuses, purchase student academic and athletic equipment, guide and support athletic and academic programming, and distribute scholarships for underprivileged students.
